



Humana Communities Benefit Online Voting Rules

[Humana Communities Benefit](#) is a charitable-giving program funded by the Humana Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Humana Inc. The 2015 program will award a multi-year \$350,000 grant to one eligible nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization in each of the following communities: Fort Lauderdale, Fla., Knoxville, Tenn., and New Orleans.

Voters can help boost their favorite, participating nonprofit's chance of winning the \$350,000 Humana Communities Benefit grant by voting for the organization they feel is the most deserving in each community.

Who Can Vote?:

The general U.S. public will have ten consecutive days to vote for the organization in each community they believe is most deserving of the Humana Communities Benefit funding.

Voting Period:

The 2015 Humana Communities Benefit Online Community Vote commences at 12:01 a.m. EDT on Tuesday, August 11th, 2015. Voting will end at 5:00 p.m. EDT on Friday, August 21st, 2015.

Voting for Proposals:

You can vote via email, Facebook and Twitter once per method daily (12:00 a.m. – 11:59 p.m.) from 12:01 a.m. EDT on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 through August 21, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. EDT.

Voters can cast a ballot for a nonprofit in each of the three markets daily via legitimate email, Facebook and Twitter accounts. Go to HumanaHCBVote.com, click on "cast a vote," and you will see further instructions.

All voters must use a valid email address, valid Facebook account, and/or valid Twitter account for voting. Humana will eliminate votes from any accounts (email, Facebook, Twitter) that, in its sole discretion, it deems illegitimate.

Votes are cast at the discretion of the voter. No corrections will be made once vote has been cast.

Winning Organization:

The Humana Communities Benefit Online Community Vote account for 20 percent of the nonprofit's total score. The online results are incorporated into the final round of the judging process, when a panel of community leaders narrows the finalists down to one winning organization in each city. The winning organizations will be announced on Humana.com/HCB the week of September 21, 2015.

Award:

Nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations in Fort Lauderdale, Knoxville and New Orleans that aim to transform their communities by lowering barriers to health and well-being – and whose specific focus or overall efforts address diabetes and/or congestive heart failure – will be awarded a \$350,000 grant from the Humana Foundation. Each of the three winning organizations will receive \$200,000 the first year; \$100,000 the second year; and \$50,000 the third year.

**Privacy and Use of Data:**

Humana will not use collected user data for third party distribution, and will not sell or use your data in any way other than for the administration of the online vote.

Voters hereby waive and release, and agree to hold harmless the Sponsor, all promotions and advertising agencies, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, distributors, advertising and promotions agencies and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents, from and against, any and all rights, claims and causes of action whatsoever that they may have, or which may arise, against any of them for any liability for any matter, cause or thing whatsoever, including but not limited to any injury, loss, or damage, whether direct, compensatory, incidental or consequential, to person, including death and property, arising in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from their participation in the Online Community Vote.
